

301 Course Syllabus

Course Description:

301 is the initial course for HSK Level 3, serving as a transitional stage from elementary to intermediate levels.

Learners should:

- Have completed HSK 2 course (class 202 in this program)
- Master approximately **300** Chinese words
- Be able to use Chinese to greet others, talk about **personal situations, hobbies, simple experiences**, and ask others questions, etc.

In Class 301, learners can:

- Master **600** new words
- Get accustomed to expressing themselves with **long sentences**
- Use more complex sentence structures to fulfill communicative functions such as **expressing personal opinions, describing time sequences, stating actions, and making comparisons**
- Accomplish tasks like reading and writing **Chinese characters**, and know more about Chinese culture through characters, in order to **overcome the fear of them**

Meanwhile, we will introduce **keywords to help learners understanding Modern China better**. Extra vocabulary will be supplied according to the living and social demands of learners.
